Professional Services

Purpose

Although not required by law, it is the policy of the Board to periodically obtain competitive proposals for certain professional services, as outlined in this Policy and the accompanying Administrative Regulation.

The Board is committed to:

- enhancing value through providing reasonable opportunity for fair, competitive, local, objective, non-discriminatory purchasing and procurement;
- providing cost effective programs;
- making decisions and policy with integrity, accountability and transparency;
- appropriately managing risk; and
- ensuring compliance with all relevant policies, regulations, and applicable law.

The Superintendent or designee shall prepare a timeline and procedures to assure compliance with this Board Policy in accordance with applicable law. There shall be a mandatory review of select professional services every five years.

In addition to the procedures outlined in the accompanying Administrative Regulation, the Superintendent, Chief Financial Officer or their designee(s) are authorized to obtain competitive bids or price quotations when not required by Board Policy or applicable law, but, where in the judgment of the Superintendent, Chief Financial Officer or their designee(s), obtaining such bids or quotations is determined to be in the District's best interests.
