Short story submissions will be grouped based on grade, subject or style depending on the number and types of submissions received. Short story submissions are open to all grades (K-6) and 4th - 6th graders may choose to write an individual book.

Upon publication, all books will be available in the library for check out by all students. Soft cover copies of individual books will be returned to their authors at the end of their final year at Montgomery while anthology collections will remain in the library for future classes to enjoy.

Additional soft and hard cover copies of both individual and anthology books will be available to order when your student submits their work.
