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What is the Montgomery Home & School Association?

The Montgomery Home & School is a registered 5O1(C) 3 non-profit organization dedicated to the enrichment of our children's educational experience. Home & School volunteers are responsible for coordinating events, organizing fundraisers, and providing a solid support parent-led system for both teachers and families. Through our fundraising efforts, we are able to supplement Montgomery's curriculum through field trips, assemblies, fitness equipment, library books and other educational materials. Additionally, we provide an important social element to Montgomery with a fun-filled calendar of events throughout the year. Creating a positive, inclusive environment where every child feels welcome and involved is a crucial aspect of our work at Home & School.

What Does Home & School Fundraising Pay For?

Through our fundraising efforts, Home & School raises approximately \$86 per child in our school. This covers costs for things the school district does not supply but are instrumental in each child's experience at Montgomery. Field trip fees and bus rentals, assemblies, library books, learning materials, Olympic Day t-shirts, and a variety of FREE family events throughout the year are just a few of the costs covered by Home & School.

Additionally, Home & School has historically been able to make generous gifts to Montgomery that the entire student body enjoys and benefits from. These include the electronic school sign, a gaga pit, a sensory hallway and murals in the student bathrooms and School Store. Home & School also provides each teacher with spending money for necessary school supplies and materials at the beginning of each year.
